FEE DESCRIPTIONS:

College: University fee mandatory for all graduate students enrolled in on-campus programs and entitles each student to student publications; admission to college social events, student-sponsored concerts and lectures; shuttle and Pittsburgh Regional Transit (PRT) transportation; and membership in student organizations. This fee does not apply to students enrolled in fully online programs.

Technology: University fee mandatory for all graduate students and entitles each student to standard university-provided software (e.g., Microsoft 365), Helpdesk support, campus connectivity and infrastructure, computer labs, and other IT services.

Liability: Supports liability coverage per conditions of affiliation agreements.

Lab: Supports required lab materials provided by the program.

Simulation: Supports subcontracted simulation services (Standardized Patients, High Fidelity simulation experiences).

Digital Resource: Supports subscriptions/licensing for e-resources (e.g., Simucase, Grammarly).

Clinical: Supports affiliation fees, licenses for clinical software, and administrative support for capstone and fieldwork placements.

Professional: Supports payment for student membership to professional associations, clinical attire (polos/nametags), etc.
