ATHLETIC TRAINING

Graduate Assistant

This Graduate Assistant provides support to programs and faculty and maintains the Human Performance and Athletic Training Labs. GAs with independent laboratory skills may support faculty research labs through independent experiments, and training of undergraduate students. Responsibilities are assigned based on departmental need and applicant skill-set.

PSYCHOLOGY

Graduate Assistant

Multiple positions

An assistant working with the graduate psychology programs may have a number of different responsibilities, including but not limited to: departmental support in its data collection and research activities, including data analysis; writing and research; and administrative tasks.

Graduate Teaching Assistant

Multiple positions

Teaching Assistants will assist faculty with *undergraduate* psychology courses. Specific responsibilities may include: assisting with course preparation/maintenance, assisting professors during class time, and providing students with feedback outside class time.

Graduate Teaching & Research Fellowship

Multiple positions

Responsibilities for these assistants include teaching, research activities, and administrative tasks. Specifically, students will assist with course preparation/maintenance; assist professors during class time; provide students with feedback outside class time; and conduct literature reviews.

Success Coach Graduate Assistantship

Multiple positions, open to PsyD/MSCP students only

Success Coaches interact with undergraduate students in one-on-one sessions and through classroom interactions while co-facilitating a 1-credit *Strategies for Success in College* course, which focuses on providing first-year and transfer students with the resources they need to succeed at Chatham. Success Coaches assist and support students with issues that might prevent their successful transition to and ability to stay in college. They develop ongoing relationships with the undergraduate students and effect real change in their lives. Success Coaches gain significant experience through training and working with their SCGA cohort, co-facilitating with Chatham faculty and staff, and mentoring undergraduate students. **NOTE:** this GA position requires a separate application for consideration.

Graduate Teaching & Research Fellow: Pennsylvania Center for Women and Politics (PCWP)

This assistant will help support the Pennsylvania Center for Women and Politics (PCWP) in its data collection and analysis, writing, and research related to women in politics and public policy in Pennsylvania.

Editorial Assistant, *Political Science Journal*

This graduate assistant will aid in the creation of the *Political Science Journal*. Specific responsibilities include: copy-editing, journal organization and layout, proof-reading, and other tasks as assigned.
